**Event Venue: Vangchhia and Farkawn**

**The Department of Geography, ICFAI University conducted a comprehensive field study at Vangchhia (Kawtchhuah ropui/ ancient settlement) and Farkawn (Mizo historical monument). The study aimed to study, explore and document the geographical, cultural, and historical significance of these two sites.**

At Vangchhia, the research team investigated the ancient settlement's spatial layout, architecture, and archaeological features. They also interacted with local communities to gather insights into the site's historical and cultural importance.

At Farkawn, the team focused on the Mizo historical monument, examining its architectural design, historical context, and cultural relevance. They also assessed the site's potential for sustainable tourism development and its role in preserving Mizo heritage.

Through this field study, the Department of Geography at ICFAI University contributed to a deeper understanding of Mizoram's rich cultural and historical landscape, while also promoting interdisciplinary research and community engagement.
