Sub:- Inspection of ICFAI University, Mizoram (State Private University).

Sir,

I am directed to refer to the visit of the Expert Committee to ICFAI University, Mizoram on 12th - 13th August, 2009 to assess its physical and academic infrastructure and to say that the Report was considered by the Commission in its 463rd meeting held on 25th September, 2009 (Item No. 5.13). The Commission resolved as under:-

“The Commission considered the Report of the Expert Committee constituted by Chairman, UGC to ascertain the physical and academic infrastructural facilities of Institute of Chartered Financial Analysts of India University, Mizoram a State Private University established by State Government of Mizoram and approved the same. The University is empowered to award degrees as specified by UGC under Section 22 of the UGC Act, 1956 at its approved campuses subject to approval of the respective statutory councils, wherever required. The Commission further resolved that the report of the Committee may be communicated to the University for Compliance of the deficiencies/suggestions within a period of three months. After receipt of compliance, the Chairman was authorized to approve the same and communicate to the University.

It was further decided that the University will not be eligible for any assistance from UGC.

The University may be further advised to adhere to the rules, regulations and guidelines of the Commission available on the website.”

Accordingly, you are requested to send compliance report in respect of the observations / suggestions / deficiencies pointed out by the UGC Expert Committee. A copy of the report is enclosed.

Apart from the above, it may also please be noted that the University has to take an immediate action on the following:

- iii) To ensure that no off campus centre(s) is opened by the University outside the territorial jurisdiction of the State in view of the judgement of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in case of Prof. Yashpal vs. Government of Chhattisgarh.
- iv) In case the university has already started any off-campus centre outside the State, it must be immediately closed. It may also be ensured that any off-campus centre even within the State shall be opened only as per the provisions laid down in the UGC (Establishment of and maintenance of Standards in Private Universities) Regulations, 2003 and with the prior approval of UGC.
